ORDERING YOUR CORPORATE LIFT PASSES

1. Please fill out the attached form with the address where you would like your passes sent. Corporate Lift Pass Packages will be sent by Canada Post XpressPost service in early October 2014. Please be sure to provide us with your complete mailing address, e-mail address and contact information. XpressPost packages will require a signature upon delivery. **Please note that if you do not fill out where you plan to use your lift passes, your order will not be processed.**
2. Make your certified cheque or money order payable to: "**CANADIAN SKI COUNCIL**".
 - a. We recommend that you provide us with a certified cheque to ensure your order goes through swiftly.
 - b. Personal cheques are accepted. However, should there be any problems with bounced cheques, you may lose your opportunity to purchase passes and could be charged the appropriate bank charges and an administration fee.
3. Please mail or courier your certified cheque or money order (or fax your VISA/MasterCard payment) and order form to the following address (or fax number) as soon as possible.

2014/2015 MANDATORY RULES & REGULATIONS

It is very important that you read the mandatory rules and regulations below before proceeding with your purchase order.

- There is a limit of (4) lift pass packages for purchase. Each package comes with 20 passes.
- Lift passes cannot be redeemed by groups larger than eight people per visit.
- Lift passes cannot be used in conjunction with any other coupon, discount, or promotion, **including the Grade 4 & 5 SnowPass Program.**
- The Canadian Ski Council is not responsible for lost, stolen or unused passes due to inclement weather, injury or medical conditions.
- All issued lift passes expire at the end of the 2014/2015 winter season (April 30, 2015).
- Ticket refunds or ticket exchanges will not be given **UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**
- Lift passes have no cash value and cannot be resold **UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**
- **CORPORATE LIFT PASSES CANNOT BE RESOLD FOR ANY REASON.** If you or anyone in possession of your pass are caught reselling them in ski area parking lots, on the internet (Kijiji, Ebay, Craigslist etc.) or anywhere else, the ski area has the right to confiscate the passes and take legal action. The CSC will also de-activate all remaining passes and blacklist the purchaser from purchasing in the future.
- Orders accompanied by post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
- If you are not paying by VISA or MasterCard, it is recommended that you courier your cheque and order form, as it ensures that your lift pass order will arrive at our office safely, thus guaranteeing your purchase.
- Passes will be distributed on a first-come first-served basis until the limited number of passes have sold out. If you submit a lift pass order after the passes have already sold out, your order will be returned with your payment in full.
- Lift passes, along with a detailed list of all participating ski areas, will be sent to you by Xpresspost in advance of the 2014/2015 ski season.
- For any ski area marked with an asterisk (*), please phone the ski area to book your lift ticket in advance.
- Other restrictions may/could apply at participating ski areas, including blackout periods during March Break, Christmas Holidays, etc. Please check with the Canadian Ski Council when purchasing your passes. Ski areas have the right to drop out of the program at any time.
